POLITICAL SCIENCE 385, SUMMER II, AMERICAN POLITICS WI  
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This American Politics course studies the American state at its inception and follows its growth in the international arena. State-making ideology, global politics, cultural identity, and the ways in which these entities show up in Hawaiian sovereign space is analyzed. The American playground/war machine “hidden in plain sight” in Hawai‘i brings the theoretical into the practical. These contemporary politics of tourism and the military are reviewed, and the spaces of engagement with these entities are further recognized.

The readings for this class consist of novels, historical accounts, and articles. We will also be taking a field trip to Fort DeRussy Military Reservation at the end of the semester. Grading is based on class participation, daily and weekly papers, group presentations, and the final paper and presentation.
